Malout Institute of Management & Information Technology (MIMIT), Malout is brought up under the able supervision of Governors, headed by the Honorable Minister of Technical Education, Govt. of Punjab, located in the Green Field Enclave, Malout (Punjab), the self contained campus is a beautiful academic and administrative three storied buildings broaden over 25 acres land which has been magnificently and aesthetically designed by the Chief Architect of Punjab. It's the first institute of its kind for providing education & training in Management & Information Technology, established in the Northern belt of India in 1998. MIMIT Central Library

MIMIT has 10500 sq. ft. double story well-stocked library. It has three reading halls outfitted with best furnishings. One is open and other two are fully air-conditioned reading halls. Library has also one discussion chamber. MIMIT library has the collection of more than 25000 books including latest and rare titles. It has subscription to 106 printed journals & more than 500 E-Journals (Subscribed through AICTE-INDEST Consortium, which includes IEL Online, Science Direct and ASME) and 17 daily newspapers. It has more than 3200 Compact Discs of Softwares, Digital Books, Utilitywares and Resources. The library is inter-linked with DELNET (Developing Library Network, New Delhi) enabling the readers to avail any information throughout the network.
